## Organisations can apply for up to £200K to develop AI tools for assessment and feedback for pupils.

The aim of this competition is to develop tools which use generative AI to support teachers with assessing progress and providing feedback, known as formative assessment. These tools must support high quality education through evidence based teaching and learning approaches. These must align with relevant standards such as the National Curriculum or Early Years Foundation Stages (EYFS). Successful applicants will have access to a quality assured library of educational content and code optimised for use with large language models.

### Proposal Requirements

- Developing a formative assessment or feedback tool which is based on generative AI or LLM capability
- Develop a tool aligned with the relevant standards such as Early years foundation stage or the national curriculum or 16-19 study programmes
- Develop a tool based on a quality assured library of educational content and code optimized for use with LLM's
- Develop a tool with supports teachers with assessing learning and development
- Your project must support teachers to either assess learning, give effective feedback or both.

### Eligibility

- Projects lead must be a UK based organization of any size in the UK
- You can work alone or with subcontracted skills and expertise of others from business, research organisations or the third sector.
- Be able to start the project by 11<sup>th</sup> November 2024
- End by 31<sup>st</sup> March 2025
